LETTER OF INTENT FOR COOPERATION

BETWEEN

UNIVERSITI TEKNIKAL MARA SDN. BHD. (UniKL)

AND

UNIVERSITAS ISLAM NEGERI SUNAN KALIJAGA (UIN SUKA)

In order to promote the mutual interests between **UNIVERSITI TEKNIKAL MARA SDN. BHD. (Company No. 200201002469 / 570132-T)**, a company duly incorporated under the laws of Malaysia for managing **UNIVERSITI KUALA LUMPUR**, an institution of higher learning established and registered in Malaysia under the Private Higher Educational Institutions Act 1996 and having its Chancellery address at 1016, Jalan Sultan Ismail, 50250 Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia (hereinafter referred to as "**UniKL**") and **UNIVERSITAS ISLAM NEGERI SUNAN KALIJAGA** an institution duly incorporated under the laws of Indonesia and having its address at Jl. Laksda Adisucipto, Papringan, Caturtunggal, Kec. Depok, Kabupaten Sleman, Daerah Istimewa Yogyakarta 55281, Indonesia (hereinafter referred to as "**UIN SUKA**").

(Both **UniKL** and **UIN SUKA** shall hereinafter collectively be referred to as "**Parties**" and individually as "**Party**").

UniKL and **UIN SUKA** agree to exercise their best efforts to explore the possibility of future collaboration in the following areas:

- (a) To explore future opportunities for teaching and learning collaboration at UIN SUKA's campus in Indonesia, including the possibility of UniKL faculty members conducting selected academic sessions, short-term teaching assignments, or training workshops, either on-site or through online platforms.
- (b) To promote broader academic collaboration including, but not limited to:
 - i. Joint research and publication initiatives;
 - ii. Faculty and student mobility;
 - iii. Co-hosted workshops, seminars, and conferences;
 - iv. Capacity building, technical training, and curriculum sharing;

- v. Short-term academic engagements, including guest lectures, academic talks, and visiting scholar programmes;
- vi. Cultural and social engagement activities;
- vii. Joint grant applications and collaborative projects;
- viii. Knowledge transfer initiatives arising from joint research, including translational activities, commercialization of outcomes, community-focused applications, or specialized training based on research findings; and

(c) Any other areas of cooperation to be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

(hereinafter collectively referred to as "**Cooperation**").

Parties understand that any financial arrangements with regard to the Cooperation will depend on the availability of funds, and the same is subject to negotiations and mutual agreement between Parties.

Details in respect of the implementation of specific projects and the relevant terms thereof shall be mutually developed and agreed upon by Parties in writing. Any other programs shall be identified and agreed upon by Parties from time to time.

Further to Parties' intentions as contemplated by this Letter of Intent and in the event Parties wish to establish a formal cooperation or collaboration on programs or business ventures, Parties shall enter into a separate agreement. In the case where an agreement is not executed, this LOI shall prevail and be valid for a period of two (2) years only, from the date of signing of this LOI. This LOI shall not give rise to any legal process and shall not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied. Either Party may terminate or withdraw from this LOI by serving the other Party thirty (30) days notice in writing.

Any Confidential Information disclosed and exchanged during discussions and correspondences between Parties shall be kept strictly confidential by Parties, wherein the said Confidential Information shall include but are not limited to, information and data which is disclosed by a party (the disclosing party) to the other party (the receiving party) prior to, or after, the execution of this LOI, involving technical, business, marketing, policy, know-how, planning, project management and other documents, information, data and/or solutions in any form, including but not limited to any document, information or data which is designated in writing to be confidential or by its nature intended to be for the knowledge of the receiving party or if orally given, is given in the circumstances of confidence.

The use of the name, logo and/or official emblem of any of the Parties on any publication, document and/or paper is prohibited without the prior written approval of either Party. Notwithstanding this, the intellectual property rights in respect of any technological development, and any products and services development, carried out –

- (i) jointly by the Parties or research results obtained through the joint activity effort of the Parties, shall be jointly owned by the Parties in accordance with the terms to be mutually agreed upon; and
- (ii) solely and separately by the Party or the research results obtained through the sole and separate effort of the Party, shall be solely owned by the Party concerned.

The undersigned being duly authorized thereto, have signed this Letter of Intent, on this 8th DECEMBER 2025.
