**Development of the Ecosystem and Halal Center**

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on Wednesday, April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2026, in the English language, both of which are equally authentic.

**Mongolian Halal Quality Authority (MHQA)**, an Organization established and incorporated in Mongolia (Reg. no. 9072015645), a company limited by guarantee and by having its business address at Suite no. 2 Naiman Sharga Building, CHD-2 Khoroo, Ulaanbaatar, 14240, Mongolia, represented by **Noor Azman bin Kamalzaman**, in this matter acting in his capacity as Executive Director of **Mongolian Halal Quality Authority (MHQA)**, and validly acting for and on behalf of MHQA, hereinafter referred to as the **“First party”**.

**AND**

UIN Sunan Kalijaga Yogyakarta (UIN), an institution of higher education under the Ministry of Religious Affairs, was established in 1951 and has its address at Jl. Marsda Adisucipto No.1 Yogyakarta, Indonesia, 55281, represented by **Prof. Noorhaidi, M.A, M.Phil. Ph.D** in this matter acting in his capacity as Rector of UIN Sunan Kalijaga Yogyakarta, and validly acting for and on behalf of UIN Sunan Kalijaga Yogyakarta, hereinafter referred to as the **“Second party”**.

Both of them, hereinafter referred to as "the Parties," consider that their common interests will be promoted through mutual cooperation in the form of the development of the Ecosystem and Halal Industry collaboration, networking, and outreach programs; The Parties intend to enter into a partnership with the general purpose of exploring collaborative initiatives within both institutions in the field of Ecosystem and Halal Industry development.

**HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**

**ARTICLE I**

**OBJECTIVES**

The objectives of this cooperation are to explore collaborative potential, to develop networking and outreach initiatives, and to develop programs consistent with the strategic

objectives of both institutions, in line with the Parties' common goal of strengthening each institution's capacity to fulfill its mission.

## **ARTICLE II**

### **SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES**

The scope of activities of the cooperation may include, but shall not be limited to:

1. Supporting the existence of Halal Center institutions
2. Halal certification and supervision
3. Serving internship students
4. Professional development programs, training, research projects, and community service programs, within the provision of available funding of both parties; and any other co-operation that will be mutually identified and agreed upon by both Parties at later stages

## **ARTICLE III**

### **IMPLEMENTATION AGREEMENT**

A detailed description of the Scope of Activities shall be set out in an Implementation Agreement for the agreed-upon programs, which is annexed to this Memorandum of Understanding and shall constitute an integral part of this Memorandum of Understanding.

These programs shall include, but not be limited to:

1. Exchange of information and professional resources in the field of halal
2. Providing expert consultation to the Parties on the ecosystem and halal industry
3. Providing long-term and short-term internship opportunities for students
4. Organizing and supporting the advancement of the halal ecosystem, such as halal workshops and seminars
5. Explore the idea of expanding other cooperation
6. Development and implementation of an Islamic center in Mongolia
7. Any other activity that will be mutually beneficial for the parties and will foster the implementation of this agreement

Both parties agree that all specific and financial arrangements are to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds. This agreement does not create any financial obligation for either party and requires a separate agreement.

The Parties agree to seek financial support from national and international organizations for the activities and exchanges to be undertaken in the terms of this agreement

**ARTICLE IV  
OBLIGATIONS**

For mutually agreed-upon programs and projects, the obligations of UIN Sunan Kalijaga and MHQA will be documented in writing and implemented as part of an Implementation Agreement for the respective programs and projects by the designated counterparts in ARTICLE III.

**ARTICLE V  
NON-BINDING**

The Parties agree that this Memorandum of Understanding expresses only their intention and is not binding, nor does it create any legally enforceable obligations between the Parties.

**ARTICLE VI  
SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES**

Any dispute concerning the interpretations of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and negotiation.

## ARTICLE VIII

### AMENDMENT

This MOU can be reviewed or amended at any time by mutual written consent of the Parties. Such revisions or amendments shall enter into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties and shall form an integral part of this MOU.

## ARTICLE IX

### ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

1. This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of its signing.
2. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be valid for the period of 5 (five) years, and will be automatically renewed on an annual basis thereafter unless either Party notifies in writing of its intention to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding 6 (six) months prior to the expiration of this Memorandum of Understanding.
3. This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated when either Party notifies in writing of its intention to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding, providing 6 (six) months' advance notice.
4. The termination of this Memorandum of Understanding shall not affect the validity and duration of any ongoing programs or activities as agreed upon in the Memorandum of Agreement.
