This Implementing Arrangement (hereinafter referred to as the “Arrangement”) is made on 31 March 2026 by and between:

The Physics Education Study Program, Faculty of Tarbiyah and Education, State Islamic University (UIN) Sunan Kalijaga Yogyakarta, Indonesia (hereinafter referred to as “Physics Education UIN SUKA”),

AND

Leibniz Universität Hannover, represented by **Prof. Dr. rer. nat. Andreas Nehring**, (hereinafter referred to as the “Partner”).

WHEREAS, the Participants aim to strengthen academic quality through international collaboration;

WHEREAS, both Participants intend to conduct international benchmarking and curriculum alignment based on European Higher Education standards, particularly the European Qualifications Framework (EQF);

NOW, therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises recited herein, the participants agree as follows:

I. Period of Activities

The activities under this Arrangement shall be conducted on 31 March 2026, with academic contributions delivered by Prof. Dr. rer. nat. Andreas Nehring of Leibniz Universität Hannover as the invited expert in international benchmarking and curriculum alignment based on the European Qualifications Framework (EQF).

II. Status of the Invited Expert

During the implementation of this Arrangement, Prof. Dr. rer. nat. Andreas Nehring shall remain an employee of Leibniz Universität Hannover. He shall not be considered an employee, agent, or representative of the Physics Education Study Program, Faculty of Tarbiyah and Education, State Islamic University (UIN) Sunan Kalijaga Yogyakarta for any purpose.

III. Liability

Each Participant shall be responsible for its own acts and omissions. Neither Participant shall be liable for any claims, damages, or losses arising from the acts or omissions of the other Participant or the invited expert in connection with the implementation of this Arrangement.

IV. Financial Arrangements

No financial obligation shall arise between the Participants under this Arrangement. Each Participant shall bear its own costs unless otherwise agreed in writing.

V. Responsibilities of the Invited Expert

Prof. Dr. rer. nat. Andreas Nehring shall contribute to the implementation of this Arrangement by delivering academic sessions on international benchmarking and curriculum alignment based on the European Qualifications Framework (EQF); participating in academic discussions, consultations, and knowledge sharing activities; and providing expert insights on curriculum development and international academic standards. The activities will result in a curriculum benchmarking report and EQF-aligned learning outcomes.

VI. Duration of Arrangement

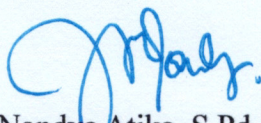

VII. Force Majeure

Neither Participant shall be held responsible for failure or delay in the performance of its obligations under this Arrangement if such failure or delay is due to force majeure events, including but not limited to acts of God, war, civil unrest, labor disputes, or government actions beyond the control of the Participants. The affected Participant shall promptly notify the other Participant and may suspend the implementation of activities until the force majeure condition has ceased.
