Assistant Professor Passapong Sripicharn, Ph.D., Dean of Faculty of Liberal Arts, Thammasat University (TU), located at 2 Prachan Road, Pranakorn, Bangkok, Thailand, hereinafter referred to as:

----- "PARTY TWO" -----

PARTY ONE and PARTY TWO hereinafter referred to as the PARTIES agree to follow up on the Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) between the Faculty of Adab and Cultural Sciences, Sunan Kalijaga State Islamic University (UIN) Yogyakarta, Indonesia and the Faculty of Liberal Arts, Thammasat University (TU), Bangkok, Thailand, with the following provisions

Article 1

PURPOSE OF COOPERATION

PARTY ONE and PARTY TWO will jointly carry out activities that are beneficial to both parties in the context of institutional development, utilizing resources that can be provided by each party to support each other in improving the quality of human resources in the fields of Education, Research and Community Service.

Article 2

SCOPE

The scope of this Cooperation Agreement includes:

- a. The field of education, concerning the exchange of lecturers (visiting lecturers) and students in the implementation of the Independent Learning program.
- b. The field of research and/or community service in the form of research collaboration among lecturers.
- c. Other matters agreed upon by both parties with reference to the applicable laws and regulations.

Article 3

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION

The implementation of these activities will be determined and arranged by PARTY ONE together with PARTY TWO and/or those authorized by both parties. The technical implementation will be arranged separately outside of this memorandum of understanding.

Article 4

FINANCING

Financing and other matters related to the implementation of this cooperation will be further arranged by both parties and other sources of funds which are inseparable addendums to this cooperation agreement.

Article 5

DURATION

This Cooperation Agreement is made and agreed upon for a period of 5 (five) years from the date of signing and may be extended by mutual agreement of both parties

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Article 6
PROBLEM RESOLUTION

Any problems arising from differences in interpretation of the content of this Cooperation Agreement or due to matters not mentioned in this Cooperation Agreement will be resolved through deliberation to achieve consensus

Article 7
CLOSING

1. Matters that are not regulated in this Cooperation Agreement will be regulated later in the form of an addendum upon agreement of the PARTIES and are an integral part of this Cooperation Agreement.
2. This Cooperation Agreement is carried out institutionally by respecting and adhering to the regulations and provisions in each institution.
3. This Cooperation Agreement is made in 2 (two) ORIGINAL copies, each bearing sufficient stamp duty, having the same legal provisions and force.
