This Implementing Arrangement (hereinafter referred to as the “Arrangement”) is established on 31 March 2026, by and between:

The Bachelor of Chemistry Education Study Program, Faculty of Tarbiyah and Education, State Islamic University (UIN) Sunan Kalijaga Yogyakarta, Indonesia (hereinafter referred to as “Chemistry Education UIN SUKA”),

AND

Leibniz Universität Hannover, represented by Prof. Dr. rer. nat. Andreas Nehring, (hereinafter referred to as the “Partner”).

WHEREAS, The Participants are committed to enhancing academic excellence through international collaboration;

WHEREAS, The Participants intend to conduct international benchmarking and curriculum alignment based on European Higher Education standards, particularly the European Qualifications Framework (EQF);

Now, therefore, based on mutual understanding and agreement, the Participants hereby agree as follows:

I. Period of Services

The activities as stipulated in this Arrangement will be conducted on 31 March 2026, with academic contributions from **Prof. Dr. rer. nat. Andreas Nehring** of Leibniz Universität Hannover, who will act as an invited expert in the field of international benchmarking and curriculum alignment based on the European Qualifications Framework (EQF).

II. Employee Status

During the implementation of this Arrangement, **Prof. Dr. rer. nat. Andreas Nehring** shall remain an academic staff member of Leibniz Universität Hannover. He shall not be considered, for any purpose, as an employee, agent, or representative of the Chemistry Education Study Program, Faculty of Tarbiyah and Education, State Islamic University (UIN) Sunan Kalijaga Yogyakarta

III. Liability

Each Participant shall be responsible for its own acts and omissions. Neither Participant shall be liable for any claims, losses, or damages arising from the acts or omissions of the other Participant or the invited expert in connection with the implementation of this Arrangement.

IV. Financial Arrangements

No financial obligations shall arise between the Participants under this Arrangement. Each Participant shall bear its own costs unless otherwise agreed in writing.

V. Responsibilities of the Invited Expert

Prof. Dr. rer. nat. Andreas Nehring shall support the implementation of this Arrangement by conducting academic sessions on international benchmarking and curriculum alignment in accordance with the European Qualifications Framework (EQF); engaging in academic discussions, consultations, and knowledge-sharing activities; and providing expert guidance on curriculum development and international academic standards. These activities shall result in a curriculum benchmarking report and learning outcomes aligned with the EQF.

VI. Duration of Arrangement

This Arrangement shall come into effect on the date of signing and shall remain valid until the completion of the agreed activities. Either Participant may terminate this Arrangement by providing written notice at least thirty (30) days in advance.

VII. Force Majeure

Neither Participant shall be held responsible for failure or delay in the performance of its obligations under this Arrangement if such failure or delay is due to force majeure events, including but not limited to acts of God, war, civil unrest, labor disputes, or government actions beyond the control of the Participants. The affected Participant shall promptly notify the other Participant and may suspend the implementation of activities until the force majeure condition has ceased.
